REGULAR MEETING

6 P.M.

Regular meeting of the Village Board held at the Village Hall and called to order by President Starcevich with the following members present: Loving, Olson, Baker, Burton, Starcevich, and Johnson. Absent were Willems and Beattie.

Motion by Burton, second by Baker to approve the December 5, 2022 regular meeting minutes. Voice votes: all votes were in favor, and the motion carried.

Motion by Burton, second by Olson to authorize the December 2022 bills. Voice votes: all votes were in favor, and the motion was carried.

Marla Whiting present to complain about garbage blowing around leaves blowing, fiberglass sheeting, and white insulation. The Board stated that leaves would be hard to control, even when raked to the road, they would still blow. The Board stated that if she sees who is doing these problems, let the Board know.

President Starcevich reported that there was no sewer update.

President Starcevich reported that maintenance superintendent Thorp put an orange brick barricade in the alley by the Walshes at South State Street.
